would also like to hold a couple of curry evenings in June. The Council	
agreed to the request, if suitable dates can be found that do not conflict	
with confirmed regular hirers.	
Anvesaka Yoga	
The Council discussed a request from Anvesaka Yoga to only pay for the	
time of actual usage of the hall. This is not allowed in the terms and	
conditions of the new hire agreement and other regular users have made	
provision for cleaning before and after their class and for setting up.	
The Council were concerned by this request and unanimously rejected it.	
They asked the Clerk to write to Anvesaka pointing out the new terms and	
conditions and insisting that they pay in advance for the time when they	
walk through the door and when they leave. That time must include	
cleaning for the safety of not just their users but those who follow.	
Bearing in mind other users have accepted the terms in full and in spirit	
and that we have a much larger cleaning bill there was no justification to
